



1. Cut around template using scissors
2. Fold rectangular paper along centre line marked **A**. Then fold top right and left corners until they meet at the crease. Use lines marked **B** as a guide. Now you have a "house" shape.
3. Fold left and right sides of paper to meet in the crease, folding along lines marked **C**.
4. Fold entire airplane again along centre crease, using line **D**.
5. To create wings, fold two corners out and back along lines marked **E**.
6. Let your child decorate the plane. Colouring is a great simple way to do it, but you could also try glitter and stickers. Just remember not to make it too heavy or it won't fly!
